Professional Experience:

While still studying in 2006 I began to run my own business " Artbox ". We were involved in sculpture conservation, building conservation and interior design for our clients. In 2007 I received an EU Grant for small businesses and started working with other design firms. I employed 2 people, until 2009 when I decided to devote more energy to my own work as an artist. I have taken part in individual and group art exhibitions in Poland and abroad .

I was commisioned to make site specific installations and sculptures an example being stone portraits of famous Polish actors on the facade of the Nove Kino Praha Cinema in Jagiellonska St, Warsaw.

In May 2010 I signed a one year part - time contract with the Labirynt Collage of Drawing and Illustration in Warsaw to teach drawing to students during the 2010 - 2011 semester.

At present I am collaborating with the Fryderyk Chopin Institute in Warsaw as a sculptor. In January 2010 I was commisioned to make a statuette for the Fryderyk Chopin Award for the MIDEM Classical Awards Festival in Cannes, 2010.

In May 2010 I was invited by The Fryderyk Chopin Institute as one of four sculptors from Europe to take part in a competition for The Fryderyk Chopin Monument in Vienna, Austria. I gained second place.

I have worked in the field of computer graphics where I made visualizations of architectural projects for clients in Krakow and Warsaw. I also make 3D computer animations for web - sites and multi - media presentations for various commercial firms ("Feba" - Swimwear, Poland, "Kocierz Inns", Poland, "SHE" - swimwear, Poland, "Lemon Studio", Poland)
