Eddie Cheang was born and raised in Macau. He received higher education in the United States, then developed his career in music production and education in Hong Kong. Eddie's professional character can be categorized as adventurous and versatile. He has always been daring to explore different creative fields and unknown territories of the market, and eventually achieved remarkable results.

Eddie possesses over 15 years of experience in professional production and education in music and sound. He was the co-founder of "AutoPlus Computer Music and Multimedia Training Center" which was the first professional digital music and audio production training center in Hong Kong. Through cooperation with the Hong Kong Productivity Council that initiated various types of professional diploma courses, Eddie and AutoPlus played a critical role in revolutionizing the education of music and sound creation in Hong Kong.

Over the years, Eddie has been invited to teach numerous courses and deliver a variety of seminars and workshops related to music and sound by respectful organizations such as the Hong Kong Education Bureau, Hong Kong Productivity Council, Hong Kong International School, Institute for Tourism Studies-Macao, Macau Polytechnic Institute, Macau Inter-University Institute (now known as St. Joseph University, Macao), and the Macau Science Center, etc. His professional experience in audio production includes music composition, sound design and narration, for TV commercials, TV dramas, games, pop songs, documentaries, web sites, etc.

Started out as a music maker, Eddie never stops exploring his artistic potential and taking new challenges in a wide range of creative frontiers. His effort and talent have gained local and international recognition in various areas such as music composition, graphic design, and board game design. Through years of intensely demanding self-training, Eddie became a truely multi-disciplined producer and educator.

In recent years, in order to teach his own children to speak better English, Eddie has been dedicated to phonetics study. Taking the advantage of his highly trained aural sensitivity and skills in audio analysis, he took an audacious attempt of exploring new methodology of teaching English pronunciation. Eddie is currently focusing on the study of comparison between Cantonese and English phonetic system. The initial objective of a family tutorial transcended to be a life-long mission of contributing to local education of English pronunciation, especially on accent reduction for Cantonese speakers.
